Venue Access & Passes: Access for Competitors will be via the Paddock Entrance from 1pm on Friday 19th April. All personnel require an e-ticket to access the venue, including Drivers. You should receive your allocation of e-tickets directly from Knockhill Racing Circuit, please check your spam folder. **Once you have arrived you must collect your allocation of wristbands for accessing the Assembly Area / Pitlane. These are available for collection from the Circuit Office between 1pm and 5pm on Friday and from 8am on Saturday. Wristbands must be worn by all personnel wishing to access the Assembly Area / Pitlane.**

Paddock: Please park neatly in the space allocated to your Championship / Series without wasting space. Private cars and non-essential vehicles should be parked in Paddock 5 (area on the left immediately after entering the Paddock entrance) and not in the main Paddock area. All vehicles and team equipment is left at the owners risk and neither the organisers nor circuit operators can be held liable for any loss or damage, howsoever caused.

Signing On for Competitors: The 'Signing On' declaration is online and included within the online Entry process. All Drivers must upload an image of their current Competition licence. Please ensure that this is completed before 5pm on Wednesday 17th April. Competitors must have their Competition licence with them at the Event as random checks may be made at any time.

Prior to taking part in the Event all Competitors must undertake the online Regulatory Knowledge Assessment (accessed via the link below) and achieve a score of 70/100 or above. Please ensure that this is completed before 5pm on Wednesday 17th April;

Additional Supplementary Regulations (Final Instructions)

Scrutineering: Please refer to the Entry list which has highlighted the cars selected to undergo a physical safety inspection. Competitors selected for a physical inspection must take their Cars and Personal Safety Equipment to the Scrutineering bay between 2pm and 5pm on Friday 19th April or from 7.30am on Saturday 20th & Sunday 21st April. The physical inspection must be completed before being allowed onto the track, **this includes the Paid Practice Sessions.**

Drivers Briefings: Drivers briefings are scheduled as follows. Attendance is mandatory;

Scottish Legends Cars Championship: 12:00 on Saturday 20th April in the Media Centre

Modsports, Scottish Mini, Fiesta & C1 Cup: 13:00 on Saturday 20th April in the Media Centre

Super Lap Scotland: 08:30 on Sunday 21st April in the Media Centre

Scottish Classic Sports & Saloon Championship: 10:00 on Sunday 21st April in the Media Centre

Timings: All timings will take place in accordance with the published timetable. The Organiser reserves the right to bring forward or delay timings to suit the conditions of the day. Please listen out for Paddock tannoy announcements.

Track Access: Access to the Track for all sessions will be via the Assembly Area. All Cars will be noise tested for compliance with NCR Chapter 7 App. 8 Arts. 5-8 prior to being released onto the Track. Drivers should go to the Assembly Area 15 minutes before published times and then when directed by the marshals they should proceed onto the Track.

End of Track Session Procedure: At the end of each Track session, all vehicles must slow down and enter the Pitlane following the marshals instructions to return to the Paddock / Parc-Fermé area as required.

Entry List: Please check your entry on the published entry list and notify us immediately if it is incorrect, this will ensure an accurate programme.

Marshals Instructions: All Marshals and Officials must 'sign on' before commencing their duties. There will be a Marshals briefing at 08:15 each day in the Wullie Brown Marshals Building. All Officials should be in position by 08:45.
