Venue Access & Paddock: Access to the paddock areas will be from 18:00 on Thursday 1st August. Any competitors arriving before this time will be held until the paddocks open at 18:00. All personnel must be in possession of an e-ticket to gain access to the venue, which will be sent via email to the Competitors registered email address (4 per competitor) from Anglesey Circuit.

The Pitlane Garages have been allocated to the Scottish MINI Cooper Cup, SEAT Supercup Ireland and Irish Touring Car Championships for the weekend (Saturday & Sunday). The garages may only be accessed from 18:00 on Friday 2nd August unless booked specifically for Friday testing with Anglesey Circuit.

Please park neatly in the space allocated to your championship / series as detailed on the published Paddock Plan (Official document) without wasting space. All non-essential vehicles & trailers should be parked outside of the main paddock. All vehicles and team equipment is left at the owners risk and neither the organisers nor circuit operators can be held liable for any loss or damage, howsoever caused. Please comply with instructions from Anglesey Circuit and/or SMRC personnel regarding the paddock. Failure to comply may result in a report to the Clerk of the Course.

Signing On for Competitors: All Drivers must agree to the ASN indemnity contained either on the Entry Form or separate document distributed by your Championship/Series Co-ordinator and provide an image of their competition licence. Competitors must have their Competition licence with them at the Event as random checks may be made at any time.

Scrutineering: Please refer to the Entry list which has highlighted the cars selected to undergo a physical safety inspection. Competitors selected for a physical inspection must take their Car and Personal Safety Equipment to the Scrutineering Bay between 15:00 and 18:30 on Friday 2nd August and from 07:30 on Saturday 3rd August. Additionally any car which has undergone repairs since the previous inspection must be re-presented for Scrutineering. The inspection must be completed before Qualifying.



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Drivers Briefings: All drivers must read the Drivers' briefing notes (Official document) in advance of the event. Additional face-to-face briefings may be called as deemed necessary, please listen out for Paddock announcements.

Timings: All timings will take place in accordance with the published timetable (Official document). The Organiser reserves the right to bring forward or delay timings to suit the conditions of the day. Please listen out for Paddock tannoy announcements.

Circuit Access: Access to the Track will be as follows;

All cars must go to the Assembly Area prior to every session. For Qualifying cars will be released into the Pitlane. Sessions will begin when the Pit Exit light turns from Red to Green. For races cars will be released directly onto the circuit to form up on the starting grid.

All Cars will be noise tested for compliance with NCR Chapter 7 App. 8 Arts. 5-8 prior to being released onto the Track. Drivers should be ready 15 minutes before published times and then when directed by the marshals they should proceed into the Pitlane / onto the Track.

End of Track Session Procedure: At the end of each track session, all vehicles must slow down, enter the Pitlane and turn immediately left to return to the Paddock / Parc-Fermé area as required and directed by Officials.

Race Starts / Grids: Prior to each race, cars will be released from the Assembly Area to form up on the grid in the positions specified on the published grid sheet. The countdown will then commence at the 1 minute signal followed by a formation lap before a standing start in accordance with the relevant Championship / Series regulations.

Official Notice Board / Information: The Official Notice Board for the event is located at Race Control. Copies of practice times & results will be published online at <u>www.smart-timing.co.uk</u>. Other event information is available on the SMRC Digital Noticeboard <u>https://noticeboard.smrc.co.uk</u>

Entry List: Please check your entry on the published entry list and notify us immediately if it is incorrect, this will ensure an accurate programme.

Marshals Instructions: All marshals and officials must 'sign on' before commencing their duties. Marshals signing on will take place in Paddock Café between 07:15 and 07:45 each day. There will be a marshals briefing at 08:00 each day at the Paddock Café. Marshals should be on post by 08:30 each day ready for a track inspection at 08:45.
